This year CICE invited two scholars from member institutions of Africa-Asia University Dialogue for Educational Development: Dr. Douglas Darko Agyei (University of Cape Coast, Ghana) and Dr. Eun Jung Chang (Seoul National University, the Republic of Korea). They took part in the program in Japan (November 11 to December 6) and played active roles in 18 lectures included 5 institution visits (Hiroshima Prefectural Education Center/ Hiroshima City Board of Education/ National Graduate Institute for Policy Study/ National Institute for Policy Research/ Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology), 2 school visits (Hiroshima Kanon Junior High School/ Higashi-Hiroshima City Mitsujo Primary School), and 2 educational visits (Fukuromach Elementary School Peace Museum/ Elpida Memory, Inc.).
