Today, workshop was held by Dr. Kazuhiro Yoshida all day. In the morning session, as a summary of the card activity on the previous day, they had the refraction time and thought about the approach of the problem (top-down and bottom-up), giving examples from international organizations. Trainees also exchanged opinions on local and policy level initiatives. There was a lively discussion on the issues of the advantages and disadvantages of both the top-down and bottom-up types, and it was a very high-level workshop.

In the previous workshops, they analyzed educational policies in countries and regions other than their own. But, today's afternoon session, they discussed the educational policies prepared by the group applying the analytical methods they had gained so far into education in their own country. They seemed to noticed the importance in setting difficulties and challenges for using the framework, such as project evaluation methods, policies and project classifications, by actually doing what they learned.
